## READ YOUR BIBLE

2 Tim 3 — "All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, so the believer may be thoroughly equipped for every good work."

The wise Christian reads Scripture, meditates on it, and puts it into practice. Do you have a daily time set aside to learn the bible and pray to God?

## SEEK WISE COUNSEL

Heb 10 — "Let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds. Let us not give up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but let us encourage one another."

He who walks with the wise becomes wise. Who are the community of people speaking to you and mentoring you?

## LOOK FOR GOD'S PROVIDENCE

Rom 8 — "And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose."

God is at work in the circumstances of our lives. What are your circumstances, and how can you see God's lessons in them?

## ASK "DOES THIS MAKE SENSE?"

Acts 15 — "'It seemed good to the Holy Spirit and to us...'"

God expects us to use our good judgment. Are you evaluating your choices, with the help of God and others?

## KEEP UP A CONVERSATION WITH GOD.

Phil 4 — "Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God."

God speaks to us daily through the Spirit. Where can you keep a journal of your thoughts and your prayer life as you seek Him?

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## **7 GREAT QUESTIONS TO ASK SOMEONE IN LIGHT OF THEIR RELATIONSHIP WITH JESUS**

1. What is your desire?
2. What is holding you back?
3. What is it costing to continue holding back?
4. How do you want to change your mind's default on that topic?
5. What new habits will you begin, to fortify your new mindset?
6. What is the most meaningful action you could take right now?
7. What new skills or support systems will ensure your success?

### **All powerful questions:**

- Come from a place of genuine curiosity.
- Are direct, simple, and usually open-ended.
- Generate creative thinking.
- Bring out underlying information.
- Encourage self-reflection.

### **Remember:**

Questions are most powerful when neither the asker nor the responder knows the answer until the question is answered.

Take the question to its deepest conclusion by asking the simple follow up question: And what else?
